## NEED ADVICE! ASK US!

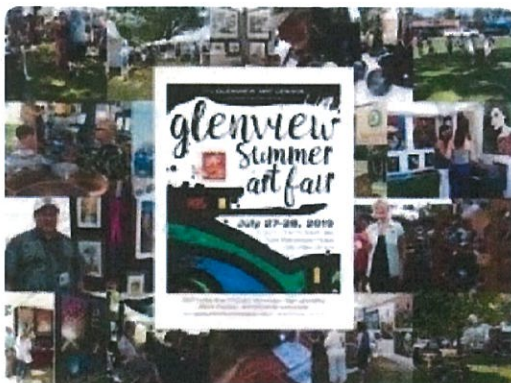
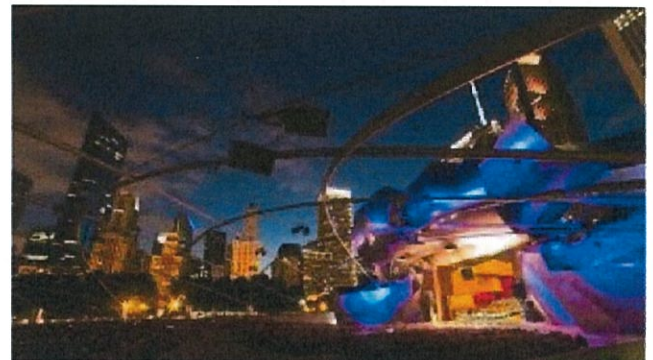

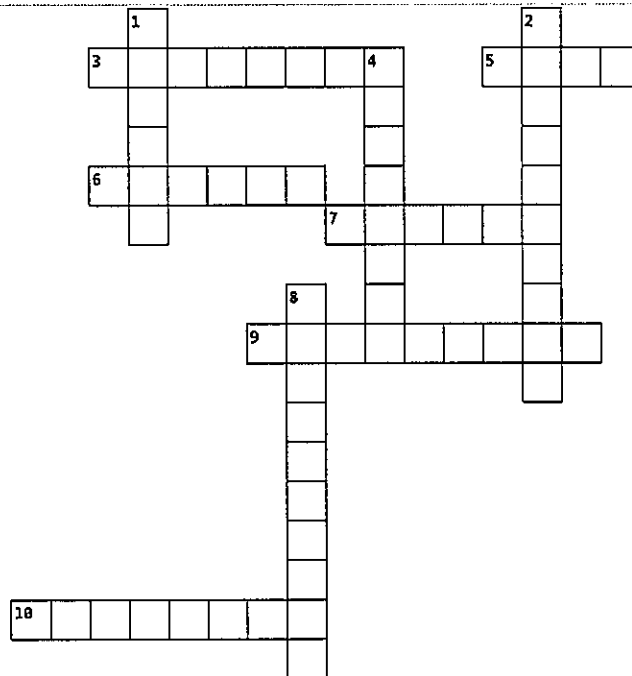

## What does **Empathy** mean?

We gathered the opinions of five teachers to find out!

**Ms. Sarich:** When I think of the word empathy a lot comes to mind. To me, empathy is the ability to understand another person's thoughts, feelings, and/or opinions that may be similar or different from your own. One can show empathy through being compassionate, accepting of others, an upstander, and a good listener. As Professor Leo Buscaglia once said "too often we underestimate the power of a smile, a kind word, a listening ear, an honest compliment, or the smallest of caring, all of which have the potential to turn a life around."

**Ms. Golden:** To me, empathy is the ability to emotionally understand what other people feel, see things from their perspective, and imagine yourself in their position. When you see another person upset, you may be able to imagine yourself in their position and feel bad for their situation. Empathy isn't about wondering how you'd feel if you were in someone else's shoes, it's imagining and attempting to understand what the other person is feeling. People who are able to experience empathy can "walk a mile in another's shoes" and try to share another person's feelings. An empathetic person may offer a compassionate action such as being someone they can talk to or offering words of kindness or encouragement. Showing empathy usually has a positive effect on those who receive it.

**Mr. Konicek:** Empathy is being able to put aside your own feelings and what is going on in your life to take perspective of what is going on with someone else's life. It often is not an easy thing to do because we often think about just ourselves and not what another person is going through. Once you try to put yourself in another person's shoes, it can often change your perspective of the world around you.

**Ms. Brueck:** I have been the "new kid" more times than I can count, but one of my first days at a new school stands out amongst the rest. My family and I had moved away and then moved back to a small town. The friends I once thought of as best friends had found new friends. I felt invisible. However, at the end of the day, a girl handed me a note. It was covered in hearts with pink glitter, and said, "I just moved here a few months ago. Do you want to be my friend?" Almost 20 years later, I still think of this small gesture, and how it made me feel at that moment. Showing empathy towards others can not only change how someone feels, but it can also leave a lasting imprint on their heart | just like it did on mine.

**Ms. Jacobs:** To me, empathy is being able to understand how someone is feeling even though you are not in the same situation. Empathetic people are able to feel the emotions of another person who is in a difficult situation. They actively attempt to understand and help the other person. Empathetic people are concerned about the happiness of other people.

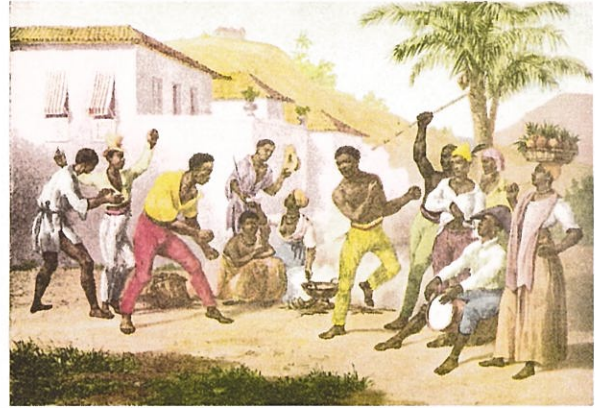
## Capoeira

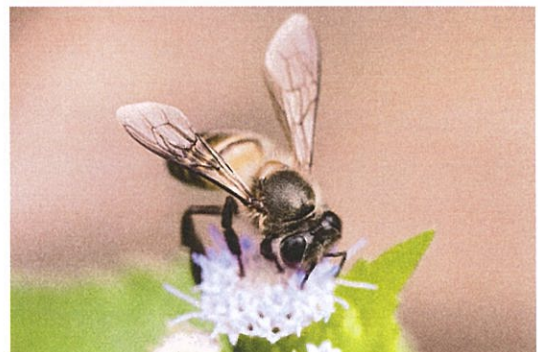

<p><b>Social media is bad for society.</b></p> <p><b>The rise of Cyberbullying</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● more than 1 in 5 teenagers from the age of 12 to 20 experience bullying online. (Ditch the Label, an anti-bullying group)</li><li>● Social media sites are “hotspots for cyberbullying,” according to psychologist Dr. Monica Barretto.</li><li>● “Teenagers have the ability to make hate pages or harass people with a click of a button. So when given the chance to say something mean about someone online anonymously, kids often forget these comments have negative impacts in the real world,” according to Taylor Lorenz, a technology reporter for the New York Times.</li></ul> <p><b>Insecurities, depression, suicide</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Instagram has made body images worse for 1 in 3 girls. 50% of girls 17-21 have seen pictures online that made them feel insecure. (Wall Street Journal)</li><li>● “Humans tend to notice the negative more than the positive,” according to Laura Carsrtensen, a psychology professor at Stanford University. So if a teen experiences negativity on social media, the negative feelings increase and can potentially lead to suicide.</li></ul>	<p><b>Social media is good for society.</b></p> <p><b>Civic Engagement</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● “Twitter, Facebook and other large social networks expose [teens] to important issues and people from all over the world. [They] realize they have a voice they didn’t have before,” says Caroline Khorr, Common Sense Media’s Parenting editor. Teens are sharing petitions, documenting and sharing acts of injustice, and encouraging their peers to take action.</li><li>● Social media also creates strong friendships. Kids spend about 7 and a half hours on social media every day while they only spend about 1 to 3 hours a day texting. (Common Sense Media) So teens connect more on social media than most other forms of communication.</li></ul> <p><b>Teenagers are more tech savvy than parents realize, so we should teach them how to use social media rather than making bans that won’t work</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● “ My parents regularly search my phone, but they don’t know about my decoy app,” “My mom gave me permission to use Instagram but she has no idea about my finsta.” This is another account so teens can do things, hidden from their parents on social media.” (Washington post)</li></ul>


# Interesting Facts




